Serious Gaming: an Innovative Method to Engage Stakeholders with Sustainable Tourism Planning

This paper introduces the method of serious gaming to reveal the complexity of destination planning but also to engage all stakeholders to work towards a more participatory approach of sustainable tourism planning.
